## **Mizmor School Givat Washington Behavior Policy**

We, the applicant and the applicant's parent/guardian, understand that participation in studies at Mizmor are dependent upon understanding and adhering to the following policies:

- 1. Givat Washington's dress policy expects that students dress modestly in public areas and when in the presence of the opposite sex. These standards of dress include but may not be limited to covering the upper body to below the shoulder area and the lower body to the knee area. Said policies may be subject to change in the future. The student is expected to respect the dress policy regardless of any future changes to said policy.
- 2. Public religious observance is followed on campus. We ask all students to respect religious observance by maintaining kosher facilities, keeping Shabbat and holidays publicly, and generally respecting this atmosphere.
- 3. Israeli law dictates that alcohol may be consumed by those who are 18 years old or older. Participants who have reached the legal Israeli age (18) are asked to consume alcohol responsibly. Those who have not reached legal Israeli age (18) are expected to refrain from alcohol consumption outside of religious rituals (e.g. drinking a responsible amount of Kiddush wine) or family functions. Regardless of age, any alcohol consumption which disturbs the participant's ability to responsibly engage in program activities may be ground for expulsion from the program.
- 4. Recreational drug use is considered grounds for expulsion from the program whether said recreational drug use is done within program grounds or elsewhere in Israel during the program dates. There will be no discussion. Participants will be sent home.
- 5. Drastically inappropriate behavior, violence, abuse of other participants, personnel and/ or program facilities will be ground for punishment and possible expulsion from the program.
- Violation of Israeli law resulting in jail time is considered grounds for expulsion from the program.
